

DATA PROTECTION POLICY

If you are a resident of the European Union (“EU”), United Kingdom, Lichtenstein, Norway, or Iceland, you may have additional rights under the EU General Data Protection Regulation (“GDPR”) in respect of Your Personal Information, as set forth. below.

What Safety Precautions Do We Use?

We seek to protect personal data using appropriate technical and organizational measures based on the type of Personal Data and the effective processing function.

The Contentecoin website uses SSL (https).

Account passwords are quick when stored in our database.

The authenticity of the request methods is guaranteed to prevent CSRF attacks (cross-site request forgery).

Contentecoin employees use Single Sign-On (SSO) and passwords and enable screen lock.

Availability of AWS and Payment Processors is limited and requires Two-Factor (2FA) certification.

Access to production data requires VPN access.

Contentecoin conducts third-party login testing.

How Do We Keep Your Personal Information?

We retain your personal information as long as you have an open account with us or if it is necessary for us to provide you with services. In some cases we retain personal information for a longer period, if doing so is required to comply with our legal obligations, resolve disputes or debt collectors, or otherwise permits or requires applicable law, regulation or regulation. After that, we store certain information in a man-made or compiled form but not in a way that will identify you personally.

Personal Information:

As noted in the Terms of Service, we do not knowingly collect or solicit personal information from anyone under the age of 16. If you are under 16, please do not attempt to sign up for the Services or submit any personal data. about you to us. If we discover that we have collected personal information from a child under the age of 16, we will remove that information as soon as possible.
