We are committed to protecting your privacy.

We collect a small amount of personal information about you to provide you with satisfactory service. This Policy outlines the types of processes that may lead to data collection for you. The purpose of this Privacy Policy is to let you understand what personal information you identify (“PI”, “Personal Information”) is collected, how and when we may use your information, who has access to this information, and how to use it to correct any inaccuracies. To better protect your privacy, we provide this information explaining our online information practices and the decisions you can make about how your information is collected and used. To make this notice more accessible, we make it available on our website.

Data collected:

We may collect any or all of the information using automated methods such as contact profiles and cookies. Personal information you provide depends on the type of service, support, or sales inquiry, and may include your name, address, telephone number, fax number and email address, dates of service provided, types of service provided, payment history, payment method, payment date, domain name or other payment information. All sensitive data is collected on a secure server and data is transferred. When your information is transferred, a security icon will appear on your browser.

Use of comfort:

This information is used to pay for and provide a service and support to our customers. We may also read this information to determine the needs of our customers and provide customer support. All reasonable precautions are taken to prevent unauthorized access to this information. This protection may require you to provide additional forms of ownership if you wish to receive detailed information about your account. Contentecoin can email their monthly letter to the first email in the file, but customers can unsubscribe from this book at any time.

We use IP addresses to analyze styles, manage our site and servers, track access, and collect demographic information for integration use. IP addresses are linked to personally identifiable information. It is possible that personal information about a customer may be included in log files due to the normal functions of IP addresses and SaaS applications.

Cookies
